

The Scholarship

The purpose of the NEOONE scholarship is to promote and support the entry of NorthEast Ohio area student leaders into the nursing profession.

- ◆ Four scholarships will provide a cash amount of \$500.00 each upon acceptance at a North East Ohio area* professional school of nursing. The scholarship is intended to encourage and assist men and women of all ages, races, and cultural backgrounds who have the potential to become nursing leaders.
- ◆ Scholarships will be awarded annually based on specific criteria, which demonstrate the potential for nursing leadership.

*NorthEast Ohio area is defined as:
Ashland, Medina, Stark, Summit, Portage, or Wayne Counties

Scholarship Criteria

The applicant must:

- ◆ Be a resident of the NorthEast Ohio area.
- ◆ Be accepted to a professional school of nursing in the North East Ohio area.
- ◆ Demonstrate leadership skills
- ◆ Provide two professional letters of reference from school, work or other professional mentors.
- ◆ Submit an essay (minimum 3 paragraphs) on your definition of leadership and the characteristics or attributes a leader demonstrates.
- ◆ Be a high school senior or college student entering a professional school of nursing (AD/BSN/MSN)

The awards will be based on Academic Performance, Leadership essay, and Leadership Activities/work history.
