## **NEWS FROM YOUR FACULTY AND STAFF**

### **Clare Murray Adams, Associate Professor of Art**

Received a second place award for her encaustic painting entitled "The White Dress" at the Massillon Museum's Stark County Artist Show. The show runs from December 2, 2007 until January 20, 2008.

### **Ann Lawson, Instructor of Communication Arts**

Presented at the National Communication Association (NCA) conference in Chicago, November 14-17, as part of a pre-conference day of training for communication faculty who teach public relations. The focus of her presentation was on teaching hybrid PR courses at small colleges. Many large universities offer several highly-specialized PR courses, whereas smaller programs must find ways to integrate multiple subjects into a single course. She presented how Advanced PR course combines service-learning, crisis and campaigns into a cohesive learning model.

### **Steve Moroney, Professor of Theology**

At the national conference of the Evangelical Theological Society (November 14-16, 2007) Steve Moroney served as a moderator for a four-paper session in "Systematic Theology: Theological Method." He also presented a paper in a session on Historical Theology entitled, "Marcion's Lingered Influence: Ancient and Modern Claims Contrasting the Old Testament God of Justice and Wrath with the New Testament God of Love and Mercy."

### **Elizabeth Patterson, Assistant Professor of Social Work**

Presented "Offering Hope in Romania: Efforts to Empower through Cross-Cultural Social Work" on November 1, 2007 at the OH NASW (National Association of Social Work) annual conference in Columbus, OH. She presented on the same subject at the AUDEM (Alliance of Universities for Democracy) annual conference in Cluj-Napoca, Romania, November 8, 2007. She also presented "The Romanian Studies Program: Study abroad partnerships in a society in transition" at the AUDEM conference on November 10, 2007.

### **Brock Reiman, Assistant Professor of Counseling**

August, 2007 presented (with Malone Adjunct Faculty member) "Treatment Interventions for Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder" for Personal and Family Counseling Services in New Philadelphia, OH.
