New Users

New Malone users can determine their User Name and password with the following information. Please visit our [Web Help FAQ](#) for complete information.

1. Username = first initial, middle initial, last name, and the number 1 (if you are not the first individual with this sequence, your last name will be followed by a 2, 3, etc.).

Sample name: John Q. Public Username: jqpublic1

2. Your default password will be a randomly generated 10 digit strand of characters. This password is in your admission letter or available from your admission counselor.

What are the expectations in an online course?

The same course demands and academic standards that are required in a classroom can also be found in an online course. Just as in a traditional classroom, students will follow a schedule as outlined in the course syllabus with deadlines for assignments.

How do I access my online courses?

To access your courses, please login to your personal account at the Malone Online Campus www.malone.edu/online. Using your Malone login credentials, enter you username and password.

How do I use my Malone email account?

All students are required to use their Malone issued email account in the Distance Learning System. You can check your email anywhere you have Internet access. The university and your instructor will communicate important information to you via email. It is recommended that you check it daily.

1. Using your web browser type in the following URL in the address bar:

Moodle Mobile App

1. From your app store, download the Moodle app to your mobile device (search “moodle app”). You can also access the mobile app at <https://download.moodle.org/mobile>
2. Enter the following URL into the site field “malone.learninghouse.com”
3. The app will ask you to go to your mobile device browser to log in. Open your browser and enter the above URL. Login using your normal Malone University credentials.
4. Return to the Moodle app and you will be logged in.
